Prerequisites	World economy and world markets, economy and foreign economic relations of Ukraine, regulation of international economic relations, microeconomics, macroeconomics, marketing, management, international trade, international insurance and taxation, customs, international organizations.
What will be studied?	Objective processes of the world economy and international trade; problems of transforming international trade into a means of accelerating world economic development; features, problems and contradictions of multilateral regulation of international trade; the role of the state in regulating the development of the economy and foreign trade in economically developed countries in the context of globalization; experience in foreign trade regulation in developing countries; the impact of the chosen model of economic transformation on the development of foreign trade.
Why is it interesting and should be learnt?	In the process of studying the discipline the student will understand the most pressing issues of international trade and foreign trade relations of Ukraine as an important component of the national economy based on macroeconomic theories, concepts, models based on world and domestic science and tested in economic practice.
What can be learnt? (study results)	As a result of studying the discipline, the student will acquire skills to justify aspects of the formation of the system of regulation of international trade at the national, international and global levels; will understand the content of certain economic theories on which modern macroeconomic science is based; get acquainted with the main methods and models of macroeconomic development of countries with different types of economies; will learn to reveal the mechanism of causal links that exist in the economy of different countries at the macro level, tools and methods of state regulation of trade.
How can the acquired knowledge and skills (competences) be used?	After studying the discipline the student will know: the problems of transforming international trade into a means of accelerating world economic development, features, problems and contradictions of multilateral regulation of international trade, the role of the state in regulating economic development and foreign trade in economically developed countries; developing; will be able to: analyze the impact of the chosen model of economic

	transformation on the development of foreign trade of the country, the objective processes of world economic development on international trade.
