Tasks of the bachelor qualifying work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to testify level of student's theoretical and practical training to professional activities; • to reflect student's ability to ask problematic questions; determine their relevance, formulate goals and research tasks; analyze and make a correct assessment of social and economic processes in the society; critically analyze the literary sources; substantiate own generalization, conclusions and proposals; • to demonstrate level of mastery of modern research methods and processing statistical and actual materials; • to show level of theoretical knowledge assimilation and skills of its application at solving practical problems, conclude, make suggestions and elaborate practical recommendations.

COMPONENT DESCRIPTION

The final qualification thesis of a bachelor is an independent individual educational and research, theoretically applied or project task, aimed at solving a complex problem in the field of international economic relations in general or international business in particular, accompanied by research and/or application of innovative approaches.

The qualification work must represent finished development of relevant scientific or professionally applied problem. It must:

- be relevant, have novelty, be performed at the level modern achievements of science and technology ;
- have focus on solutions practical tasks future professional activities;
- stimulate students' creative search of new priority scientific decisions;
- require processing of special scientific and methodological literary sources;
- provide optimal decisions choice based on application of mathematical modelling methods using modern computer technology;
- connect with scientific research plans of the head of department and other scientific subdivisions of the institution;
- generalize and develop student's research skills .

The topic of the qualification thesis must accord professional competencies provided by the educational program (<http://surl.li/bebus>). List of qualification thesis topics is formed by graduating departments, updated every academic year and approved by the decision of the academic councils of the faculties. Topics of qualification work are offered to students at the beginning of the academic year. Students have the right to propose their topic with the justification of its feasibility. In such cases advantage is given to themes that connected directly with the place of graduate's future professional activities.
