Requirements for the beginning of the study	Basic knowledge of Geography, History, International Relations
What will be studied	The features of the region political systems development; establishment and functioning of their political institutions; the course of domestic political reforms and processes in the world; interconnection and interdependence of domestic and foreign policy of the region.
Why it is interesting / necessary to study	The domestic political processes in the region cover the political, economic, social spheres of public life, and the successful implementation of reforms in domestic policy, the effective functioning of civil society institutions guarantees countries political stability, determines their international prestige.
What you can learn (learning results)	to give an expert assessment of current trends and patterns of development of political systems in the region; to analyze the peculiarities of the election campaigns at different levels (presidential, parliamentary, local); to understand the aspects of creating political coalitions during the formation of government bodies, the political elite in general; to identify issues of political leadership in the country and its regions; to evaluate the success of reforms in various spheres of public life; to characterize the participation and influence of civil society on socio-political processes in the region; as well as the state of the political culture of the society of a particular state.
How to use the acquired knowledge and skills (competencies)	Understand the features of domestic political crises in the region – political, institutional, economic, social, etc.; to analyze the peculiarities of domestic political development of the region; to be guided in carrying out reforms in various spheres of public life and the course of socio-political processes in these countries. Analyze international processes in different contexts, solve complex specialized problems and practical problems in the field of international relations, foreign policy of the region, apply knowledge of the characteristics of countries and regions.
