3. DESCRIPTION OF AN ACADEMIC COMPONENT

Abstract of the course

The syllabus of the educational component of the attestation exam is compiled in accordance with the educational and professional program International information and public communications of the bachelor's training in the specialty 291 International relations, public communications and regional studies.

Prerequisites: completed courses from the educational program

Effective preparation of students for such a form of control as a certification exam requires the formation of a system of competencies acquired during training, their actualization and highlighting of intersubject relationships, and is the task of this educational component.

The attestation exam is held in the 4th year and aims to reveal the knowledge, abilities and skills of students from a number of general education and special disciplines, the study of which is provided for in the curriculum. The certification exam consists of three theoretical questions, each of which is valued at 100 points.

The attestation exam program includes a number of disciplines, in particular: International information and public communications, Information and analytical activities in international relations, Mass communications, Strategic communications in international relations, Information policy and security, Analysis and forecasting of the foreign policy of countries and regions, Conflict studies and theory negotiations

The purpose and tasks of the educational component

The purpose of the attestation is to determine the actual compliance of the training of higher education seekers with the goals and requirements of the international relations, social

communications and regional studies program of the first (bachelor) level, to check their knowledge, abilities and skills necessary for further professional activity.

Applicants of higher education are provided with advisory assistance during preparation for the attestation exam, the generalization and systematization of the knowledge acquired during studies at the bachelor's level of higher education is stimulated, information is provided about the specifics of the procedure for conducting the attestation exam, drawing up tickets for the attestation exam and the structure of answers to them.

The main task of the attestation exam is to determine the level of theoretical preparation of graduates for the goals and requirements of the educational and professional program «International information and public communications» specialty 291 International relations, public communications and regional studies of the bachelor's level of higher education, checking the abilities and skills of higher education applicants, the ability to solve complex specialized tasks and practical problems in the field of international relations, social communication and regional studies, foreign policy activities of states, international interactions between states, international organizations and non-state actors, which are characterized by the complexity and uncertainty of conditions and involve the application of theories of social sciences and special scientific methods of researching problems international relations in the process of professional activity, which involves the application of modern theories and methods.

4. EVALUATION POLICY

Academic Integrity Policy

in any form (including the use of electronic media) is prohibited . The detection of signs of academic dishonesty during the preparation and/or taking of the certification exam is a reason for its failure, regardless of the scale of plagiarism or deception.

A student's appeal statement about his disagreement with the assessment for the certification exam issued to him by the examination board can be submitted by the student only on the day of the exam in writing addressed to the chairman of the examination board.

Deadlines and Repassing Policy

If the student did not appear at the meeting of the commission to take the attestation exam, then a note is made in the protocol of the commission that he was not certified due to non-appearance at the meeting of the commission. Students who have not passed the state exams in the term approved for them have the right to re-attestation in the next term of the commission's work within three years after graduation, provided there is a free licensed place in the chosen educational and professional program.
