Requirements for starting studies	basic knowledge of international relations and world politics, analysis and forecasting of the foreign policy of countries and regions, strategies for peace and international security.
What will be studied	the strategies used by political leaders and countries in different historical periods. Consideration of the influence of various factors on the formation and implementation of political strategies. Analysis of both successful experiences and the study of mistakes made in the development and implementation of political strategies.
Why it is interesting / should be studied?	studying the formation and development of political strategies allows a better understanding of modern global conflicts, international relations and diplomatic initiatives. The analysis of historical examples of successful and failed political strategies will help to understand the principles of action and determine the best approaches in international relations.
What you can learn (results)	studying strategies in the context of world politics contributes to the development of analytical skills of higher education graduates, such as the analysis of cause and effect relationships, risk assessment and determination of optimal courses of action. Research on the development and improvement of political strategies encourages critical thinking and the
