

It must meet the requirements of the regulations on final qualification works of 29.06.2022. and regulations on the system of prevention and detection of academic plagiarism in the scientific research activities of applicants for higher education and scientific pedagogical workers of the Lesya Ukrainka VNU dated 26.02.2021. According to the latter, qualified work must be placed in the Electronic Fund of qualification works of the University. It can be voluntarily posted by the applicant author in an electronic repository of the Lesya Ukrainka VNU for open access.

Based on the results of certification, a standard document is issued on awarding the applicant a bachelor's degree with an educational qualification – Bachelor of international economic relations with specialization "International business".
